

Wall Assembly The 1 hr fire rated framed gypsum wallboard wall assembly shall be constructed of the materials and in the manner specified in the individual U300, V300, U400, V400 or W400 Series Wall and Partition Designs in the UL Fire Resistance Directory and shall include the following construction features:
  - A. Studs Steel studs to be min 3-5/8 in. (89 mm) wide and spaced max 24 in. (610 mm) OC. Wood studs to be 2 by 4 in. (38 by 89 mm) lumber spaced max 16 in. (406 mm) OC.
  - B. Gypsum Board\* Gypsum board to be installed to a min total thickness of 5/8 in. (16 mm) on each side of wall and on each stud face within joint opening.
- 2. Joint System Nominal width of joint is 2-1/4 to 6 in. (57 to 152 mm). The joint system is designed to accommodate a max 50 percent compression or extension from its installed width. The joint system shall consist of the following:
